theology/definitions/speech he is saying. This leads to my second point. The devotions don't flow well because like all human beings Chambers has conflicting viewpoints. Some areas temptation is good and others not. One of my biggest complaints is the devotion on December 9. Throughout the book Chambers' theology is opposed to any natural
inclination (very odd). He has the following: "The things that are right, noble, and good from the natural moral excellence opposes or counteracts surrender to God, we bring our soul of its greatest battle...it is good that opposes the best. The higher up
the scale of moral excellence a person goes, the more intense the opposition to Jesus Christ." The context he is saying is to give up self will, independence, etc. We are no longer individuals. My question to this though is: does God dislike my naturalness? Did God not fashion me from the dust that moves? Does God enjoy me giving up all of myself to
become an empty vase, or does He love it when out of my will I actively seek/partner/love God? Do I not receive God at all or believe or have rational thought? CS Lewis says morality is objective, but according to Chambers that isn't true. Willard says if you want to be spiritual do
