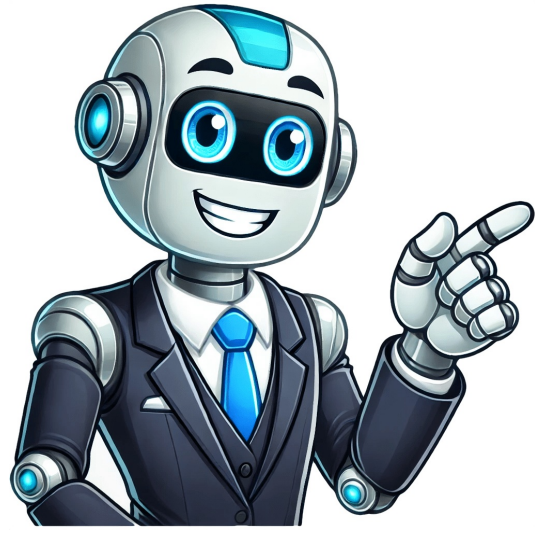


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## Quest academy west haven utah

GradeQuest Academy: Fostering Community, Creativity, and Digital Literacy GradeQuest Academy is a public charter school in West Haven, Utah, that focuses on creating a supportive community where students work together to develop essential skills like collaboration, critical thinking, and digital literacy. By promoting mastery-based learning, students have the opportunity to learn at their own pace, acquiring skills and knowledge in a depth that traditional schools may not be able to offer. The school emphasizes kindness, dignity, and respect among its students, who are encouraged to share ideas, perspectives, and experiences to cultivate a sense of shared accountability and leadership. Quest Academy's motto, "Every student, every day, whatever it takes," reflects the school's commitment to empowering students to become contributing members of society. Computer Science instruction begins in 1st grade and continues through 9th grade, covering topics such as programming, coding, website design, and utilization of digital tools like the Google Education Suite. The school's approach to technology education is designed to prepare students for success in social, academic, and professional settings. GradeQuest Academy's curriculum is focused on helping students develop a strong foundation in math and reading, with 53% of its students meeting or exceeding proficiency standards in these subjects according to state test scores. With a student-teacher ratio of 23 to 1, the school provides personalized attention and support to each student, fostering a sense of community and academic achievement. Quest Academy: A Mixed Bag of Experiences Quest Academy, a National 17:1 school with a student-teacher ratio of about 17 students per teacher, has received both positive and negative reviews from its students and parents. On one hand, many students have praised the school's mastery grade system, which they say helps them learn effectively. The teachers and staff are also commended for their caring attitude towards students' success. However, some reviewers have expressed disappointment with the school's handling of serious situations that affect students and their families. One parent reported feeling "very unprofessional" with the school's response to a critical issue. Others have criticized the school for lacking substance, relying on empty promises rather than tangible progress in areas such as math education. Despite receiving straight As at Quest, one child was found to be behind in math. As a Charter School with an enrollment of 484 students and 28 full-time teachers, Quest Academy aims to provide free public elementary and secondary education. However, some reviewers have raised concerns about the quality of clubs and activities available. Interestingly, Questhaven Retreat, a nearby Christ-Centered Spiritual Retreat and Nature Preserve, offers a unique experience in Christian Mysticism through worship, study, and renewal. Founded in 1940 by Reverends Flower and Lawrence Newhouse, Questhaven is nestled among chaparral-covered hills in northern San Diego County. Every Sunday at 10:45 a.m., Church Services are held with annual Weekend Retreats honoring Easter, Christmas, Michaelmas, and Summer. Questhaven is a school designed to help sincere seekers find their way with God through our Path of Christian Mysticism, which goes beyond just believing in God. You'll find selected book titles, recorded lectures, and guided meditations by Rev. Flower A. Newhouse. One sign of spiritual growth is taking on more responsibility for supporting the Good and volunteering to assume new roles. During the annual Open Enrollment in January, parents are notified when a position becomes available for their child. There's also the possibility of positions opening mid-year. Quest students feel safe, comfortable, and empowered in their learning environment, which is reflected in the love, passion, and positive vibe that members of this community share every day.
